Definition:

Dysmenorrhea is defined as Painful menstruation

- The term dysmenorrhea is derived from the Greek words:
 - dys, meaning difficult/painful/abnormal
 - meno, meaning month
 - rrhea, meaning flow

- Primary: common and normal
- Secondary: signals reproductive tract disease

Dysmenorrhea is divided into two categories:

- 1. Primary dysmenorrhea
- 2. Secondary dysmenorrhea

DYSMENORRHEA CAUSES

Primary Dysmenorrhea

Natural uterine contractions due to high prostaglandin concentration, aimed at shedding its lining


Secondary Dysmenorrhea

- PID






Dysmenorrhea Causes





	Ovarian cysts





To treat primary dysmenorrhea:

- pain relief: NSAIDs, cyclooxygenase- 2 inhibitor
- hormonal contraceptives
