HANTA VIRUS INFECTIONS

- caused by a group of viruses known as hantaviruses.
- cause two serious illnesses in humans.
 - 1. Hemorrhagic fever with renal syndrome (HFRS) and
 - 2. Hantavirus pulmonary syndrome (HPS)
- · Fatal mortality rate 38%.

Symptoms of Hanta Virus Infections

Early Symptoms

- fatigue,
- fever
- muscle aches


Late Symptoms

- · coughing and shortness of breath
- · Lungs filled with fluid



How humans become infected?

- Through contact with infected rodent excreta (urine, saliva, feces, dead body or blood)
- · Being inhaled, Mucosa contact or bite

Source of Hanta Virus Infections

- There are several distinct Hanta viruses, each associated with specific Rodent Host
- Humans get infected by inhaling aerosols of Rodent excreta. (Urine, Feces, Saliva)









Clinical features

- A 2to3 week incubation period is followed by a protracted clinical course
- Typical phases:
 - Febrile period,
 - · Hypotension,
 - Oliguria,
 - · Diuresis and
 - Convalescence phase.



Treatment for HPS

 There is no specific treatment, cure, or vaccine for Hantavirus infection.

 The earlier the patient is brought in to intensive care, the better.

Hantavirus is difficult to diagnose in early stages
