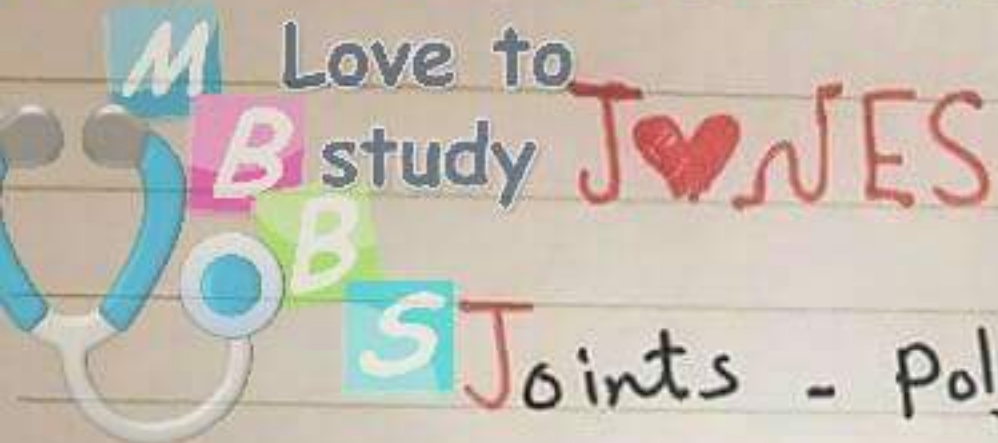

Iron	→	Deferoxamine
