


Age of reflex disappearance - 3-4 months

Keep the newborn in vertical position and allow one or both foot to touch the firm surface, the newborn response by Rapid flexion and extension of lower extremities and it gives the appearance that the newborn is dancing or walking.








Age of reflex disappearance - 3-6 months


Hold the newborn in semi sitting position and then immediately drops down the head end 30 degree.

The newborn responses by sharp extension with abduction followed by sharp flexion and adduction, the thumb and four fingers in C shaped position.






Age of reflex disappearance -

3-4 months

A reflex that is seen in normal newborn babies, who automatically turn the face toward the stimulus and make sucking (rooting) motions with the mouth when the cheek or lip is touched. The rooting reflex helps to ensure successful breastfeeding.
